#### RBN Announces Appointment of New Traditional Councillors

The Royal Bafokeng Nation is proud to reaffirm its commitment to participatory governance and democracy by announcing seven of eighteen newly elected councilors to the Royal Bafokeng Traditional Council.

The elections held on 21 July 2012 voted for the 40% of the Royal Bafokeng Nation Traditional Council, as provided for by the relevant legislation. As per legal provision, the other 60% of the 18 members will be selected by *Kgosi* Leruo Molotlegi. The councilors will serve for a period of five years.

Traditional councils are established in terms of Section 6(1) of the North West Traditional Leadership Framework Act (NWTLFA). The Royal Bafokeng Nation is recognised as a traditional community and should have Traditional Council as provided for by the Act. According to a proclamation by the Premier of North West Province, members of the Royal Bafokeng Nation are entitled to elect seven councillors and eleven appointed councillors to serve in the Traditional Council.
