My Future My Business 2011



- To assist entrepreneurs to improve and develop their business plans i.o.t translate ideas to business implementation
- A pilot was run between July 2011 and March 2012
- Project supported by major developmental organisations (SA Institute of Entrepreneurship, Khula, IDC, SEDA, NYDA and DFIs)
- Pilot produced 20 competent SMME
 - 10 Start-ups with solid business ideas and detailed business plans
 - 10 Existing companies currently trading
- 4 of the 20 have already been identified for opportunities at Impala Platinum
